

## Marin Shakespeare Company Tech Intern Program 2014

Marin Shakespeare Company presents award-winning outdoor summer Shakespeare performances at the Forest Meadows Amphitheatre on the campus of Dominican University in San Rafael, California, twelve miles north of San Francisco. Our Tech Intern Program, geared towards high students, is an opportunity to learn about a variety of topics of theatre production, and to gain hands-on experience in theatre tech and front-of-house.

The Technical Theatre Intern Program will accept up to eight high school students, and possibly older students. Each Intern will be receive a stipend of \$300. Our goal is to give interested students an opportunity to learn about all phases of production, and to train students who may become theatre technicians of the future.

The program will include instruction in:

Artistic Direction
Stage Management
Set Design, Construction and Scenic Art
Lighting Design
Prop Design
House Management & Audience Services

Interns will engage in hands-on, participatory learning, including rehearsal assistance, prop and set building, painting, and light hang and focus. Interns will be expected to participate in performances running lights and/or sound for productions, or helping with House Management and Audience Services. Interns will be expected to complete 60 - 80 hours of work/study. You should be available for all or most of the run of one mainstage production.

Instructors will include Marin Shakespeare Company's Artistic Director, Managing Director, Technical Director, Designers, and Stage Manager.

- Pre-production work/study June 9 through July 18, with some projects in August.

  Projects will include set building and painting, prop making, and hanging and focusing lights.
- Interns are invited attend production meetings and rehearsals, and can assist the stage management team at rehearsals.
- Interns will be given a performance assignment, which will require being available for all or most tech/dress rehearsals and performances of at least one production.

Each Intern's Schedule will be based on the student's availability; this is a work/study

program – the more time you devote to being at the theatre, the more you will get out of the program. You will be responsible for checking email for daily schedule updates.
